














BEST PPC	Installation And Operations Manual With notes	
Installation		
<p>Installation Step 1</p> <p>Installation Step 2</p>	<p>After downloading (or receiving via email), unzip the self-extracting file bestppc.exe into a directory of your choice. You should see the following files after the extraction process.</p> <p>Connect your PocketPC to your laptop and ensure that your ActiveSync connection is active. If you are not sure how to do this, read your PocketPC installation software.</p>	
<p>Installation Step 3</p>	<p>At this point, double click on the file Setup.exe (as in the diagram in installation step 1). This will invoke the installation screen. You can leave the destination folder as is or change it if you wish.</p>	



<p>Installation Step 4</p>	<p>At this point the software will begin communications with the PocketPC device and will self start the installation.</p>	
<p>Installation Step 5</p>	<p>You will now be queried as to whether you want to install the software in the default application directory.</p>	
<p>Installation Step 6</p>	<p>The software will now begin the transmission to the PocketPC and begin the installation of BESTPPC.</p>	
<p>Installation Step 7</p>	<p>At this point the download to the Pocket PC is complete and you should follow the directions on the screen of your PocketPC.</p>	

	Operations	
<p>Operation (preparation)</p>	<p>You should become familiar with the process of viewing and moving files between your PC and the PocketPC. The PocketPC will appear as an item "Mobile Device" when using your File Explorer program on your PC. When the PocketPC and computer are connected you should be able to move data file and configuration files back and forth as necessary. The installation software places one sample configuration file (Peteach) on the PocketPC . YOU MUST BE FAMILIAR WITH USING THE BEST DESKTOP SOFTWARE BEFORE YOU USE THE BESTPPC. Configuration files can only be constructed with the desktop BEST software.</p>	
<p>Operation Step 1</p>	<p>After you have moved the appropriate configuration files to the PocketPC (or used the sample on that was auto installed), you can start the program.(YOU CAN DISCONNECT THE POCKETPC at this point). On the PocketPC tap on the programs menu entry and you should see an icon "BESTPPC 2001". Tap on it and you should see the screen to your right. At this point you have three options.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Quit the program. Load a configuration file. Click on the "?" mark to get information about the current version. 	

<p>Operation Step 2</p>	<p>After clicking on the "Load Configuration File" option, you should see the screen to the right. In the "Personal" folder, the default installation has placed a file PeTeach. This is the same configuration sample delivered with the desktop version. If you have placed other configuration files on the PocketPC they should be visible either in the "Personal" directory or in another directory as selected by the user. At this point you can click on the file of choice and it will be selected.</p>	
<p>Operation Step 3</p>	<p>At this point the program reverts back to the main menu. You have 3 options.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Quit the program "?" Create a New Data File. <p>The box at the bottom of the screen indicates the name of the Current Configuration File.</p>	

<p>Operation Step 4</p>	<p>If you choose "Create New Data File" the following screen will pop up. In the example on the right we have input a file name "Test1". This can be typed in with the pop up screen keyboard or an actual hard keyboard attached to the PocketPC.</p>	
<p>Operation Step 5</p>	<p>After naming a data file the main menu screen pops up. At this point you can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Quit b) "?" c) Start Recorder Session. <p>The Current Data File is also displayed in the lower section of the screen.</p>	

<p>Operation Step 5</p>	<p>If you choose "Start Recorder Session", a screen similar to the one on the right appears. The key configuration is for Peteach. For further explanation of operations see the BEST Desktop documentation. NOTE: Key labels are truncated to 3 characters due to screen size limitations. Input can be either via</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Tapping with the stylus Use of an auxiliary keyboard. (preferred) 	
<p>Operation Step 6</p>	<p>Comments, Numbers and other annotations will bring up the popup screen keyboard to allow for quick text input. (See the Desktop BEST operations manual for data collection operations).</p>	

<p>Operation Step 7</p>	<p>After you have collected your data you should press "PAUSE" in order to enable the "Exit" key. The bottom of the screen also contains a scrollable "Data Capture List" to enable users to preview collected data.</p>	
<p>Operation Step 8</p>	<p>After collecting data you can either start collecting another data file or connect the computer to the PocketPC for data transfer. If you connect the devices you should see a file similar to the one on the right that you can transfer back for analysis.</p>
